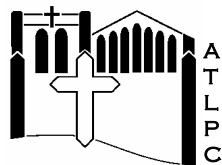

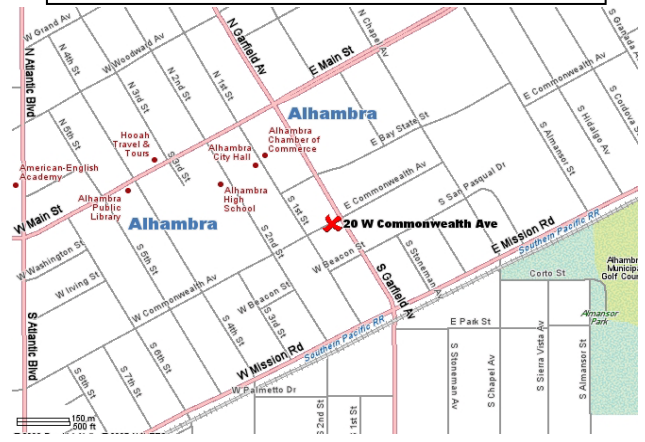

Our speaker, Michele Pillar, will dig below the surface and bring to light some of those insecurities we have and show us how to experience God's forgiveness and grace on a daily basis.

In 2009, we were blessed by Nicole Johnson's drama presentations along with her sharing on "hope". In 2012, our speaker Michele Pillar will bring a message on "grace" through her singing and sharing. Our theme for the day will be *"God, the Untangler - Sorting Through Life's Clothesline."*

"A Women's Gathering" is an opportunity for women to journey together ~ spending time in worship, the Word, and fellowship. It's a day for us to spend time away from the busyness of our daily lives to focus on what God has in store for us as uniquely created women.

Singer, speaker, author and president and founder of "Closer to Home", a non-profit organization that provides support for food, shelter, clothing and education for needy families.

Michele Pillar is a Christian recording artist, speaker and author with roots in Southern California. She has been in Christian ministry since the 1970's and is considered a pioneer in the beginnings of the contemporary Christian music genre.



Her musical career includes singing in commercial television, the classic "Misfit" album with Erick Nelson, singing lead and background vocals on the Maranatha Praise albums, duets with numerous Christian recording artists and her own successful solo career with three Grammy nominations for her work.

Michele is preparing to release a new CD as well as a semi-autobiographical book about her journey with the Lord and what He has helped her through in her life. Michele's message is about the "power of telling the truth" - incorporating scripture, life experiences and lessons taught by God on how to receive forgiveness and grace in one's life. It's about how to walk with Jesus, surrendering to God's will and purpose and experiencing victory through Christ.

She spends much of her time committed to charitable organizations and is an active volunteer in her local community.

Michele is married to jazz guitarist, Larry Carlton, and they make their home in Nashville, TN.
